### Jump Rope for Heart

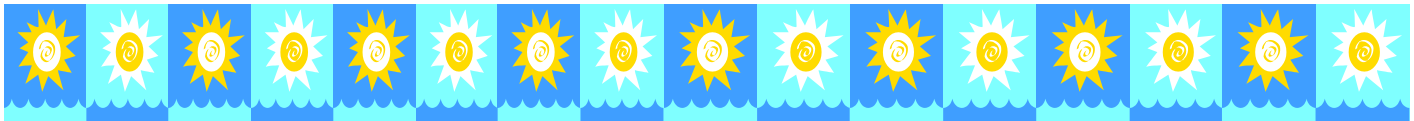
On May 22<sup>nd</sup> we held our annual Jump Rope for Heart event after fundraising for three weeks.
