We also would invite those interested in volunteering time or resources to help us realize this vision to share that intention with School Council or staff.

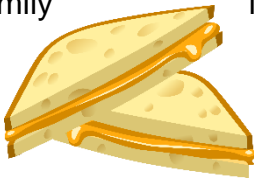
We hope all of our families will be able to come and join us on this evening of fun and shared community.
