## **School Spirit Wear**

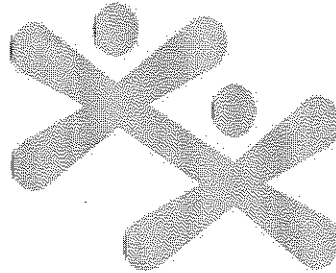
