The Good Food Box is available once a month and is full of fresh fruits and vegetables. Each box costs only \$15 and typically includes between 8-10 items, for example:

- 2lbs apples
- 5lbs potatoes
- 1 bunch radishes
- 1 bunch green onions
- 1 bunch carrots
- 4 bananas
- 1 lb green beans
- 1 cucumber
- 1 pkg mushrooms
- lettuce

By participating, you will be supporting local farmers and businesses, enjoy healthy fruits and vegetables, and save up to 30% on your food bill!

Orders are due at the school the first Tuesday of each month. Good Food Boxes will be delivered to the school the third Tuesday of each month.
