Principal's Message

The morning arrival time is important for children to have the opportunity to greet their friends and teachers. When students arrive after the bell it disrupts the morning routine of all students. Staff are busy supervising the needs of many and do not have time to safely have conversations with adults. If you wish to speak to the classroom teacher, she would be more than willing to call and have a phone conversation or set up an in-person interview. When students arrive and enter the building on time with their peers, it is easier for children to follow the routines of the class and become more independent when undressing, unpacking and getting ready to learn.

If you do arrive after the 8:50 bell, please sign your child in using the green sign in book at the office. The staff encourages that you allow your son/daughter the opportunity to independently go to his/her classroom, change their own shoes and unpack their own backpack. These skills are vital.

The staff understand that it is sometimes unavoidable to sign students out early. However, we want families to understand that this time of day is very busy in the classrooms especially between 3:50-3:10. Important information is provided, agendas are filled out and end of the day routines are established. When at all possible, please pick your child following bell time.

Visitors in the Building

Any visiting adult in the building is required to sign in at the office and wear a visitor's nametag.

We are asking our families that they do not go to the classrooms or walk through the halls.

Letting parents walk through our school during school hours creates a culture where students become accustomed to adult "strangers" moving through the halls.

Our office staff is very welcoming and accommodating. During school hours, if you need to see your child or drop off an item, these kinds of requests can be easily fulfilled.
